<u>I like to draw and paint.</u>	Design a poster advertising a holiday to a destination of your choice. 	Draw/paint a flag of a country that you are interested in.	Imagine that you are an explorer and that you have just discovered a new island. Draw a map of the island. What would people find on this island?
